ABOUT THE CONDUCTOR

Paula Martin currently serves as an Adjunct Professor in the Music Department at Lindenwood University. Professor Martin teaches University Women's Chorus, Select Women's Ensemble, and Studio Voice. Paula holds a Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the University of Missouri-Columbia. In addition she holds two Masters Degrees. The first, in Music Education with emphasis in Early American Choral Music from Southern Illinois University. The Second, with emphasis in Secondary Instruction, (choral) from University of Missouri-St. Louis. Paula was the Director of Choirs at Oakville HS for more than twenty years. Previous to that time, she taught Middle School Choir for the District of Ladue and K-12 Vocal and Instrumental Music for the Grandview R-2 School District in Jefferson County. Paula's ensembles have enjoyed many years of success, including five performances at MMEA as well as a performance for the Southwestern Divisional Conference of the American Choral Directors Association. Mrs. Martin's high school Concert Choirs and Chamber Choirs at both Grandview R-2 and more recently, Oakville Senior High School have received thirty-three years of consecutive Honor 1 Ratings at the MSHSAA sponsored State Festival for Large Ensembles. Mrs. Martin has had over fifty of her students selected to the Missouri All-State Choir and has had many students selected to ACDA Regional Honor Choirs. Paula is a frequent clinician and adjudicator, having served in these capacities throughout Missouri and the Midwest. She is an active member of NAFME, ACDA, MMEA, and MCDA. She currently serves as the R & S Chair for Women's Choir for MCDA and was the MCDA Podium Award Recipient in 2013.

ABOUT THE ACCOMPANIST

Angela Hendrick earned her bachelor's degree in Music Education from Southeast Missouri State University and holds lifetime certificates for both instrumental and vocal music. She holds master's degrees in Music from Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville and in Music Education from the University of Missouri - St. Louis. She retired in May 2015 with 30 years of experience teaching 7 years of both instrumental and vocal music from kindergarten through high school in the Grandview R-2 school district, and finishing her tenure as Director of Choirs at the Mehlville School Districts. She has served as Vice President of the St. Louis Suburban Music Educators Association twice and is a member of the MMEA, MENC, and ACDA. ABOUT THE CONDUCTOR

Character tenor Marc Schapman completed a Doctor of Music in Voice Performance at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. A native of Iowa, Mr. Schapman received his Bachelor of Arts from Luther College and his Master of Music from the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. His operatic credits include Mime in *Siegfried*, Loge in *Das Rheingold*, Goro in *Madama Butterfly*, George Gibbs in the world premiere of Ned Rorem's *Our Town*, Pheron in the Opera Circle of Cleveland world premiere of *Thamos, King of Egypt*, Spoletta in *Tosca*, Bardolfo in *Falstaff*, Kaspar in *Amahl and the Night Visitors*, Gastone in *La Traviata*, Ralph Rackstraw in *HMS Pinafore*, Nanki Poo in *The Mikado*, Nelson Deadly in *Too Many Sopranos, A Grand Night for Singing*, the Tanzmeister in *Ariadne auf Naxos*, Harry Easter in *Street Scene*, and many others. Concert appearances include Handel's *Messiah*, Gounod's *St. Cecelia Mass*, Beethoven's *Missa Solemnis*, Rossini's *Stabat Mater*, Mozart's *Coronation Mass*, Mozart's *Requiem*, and Beethoven's *9th Symphony*. He made his Carnegie Hall debut singing the world-premiere of Edwin Penhorwood's *An American Requiem*. Currently, Mr. Schapman serves as Associate Professor Music at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville. In addition to his SIUE duties, Mr. Schapman serves as a voice teacher for Opera Theater of St. Louis' Artists-in-Training and is the Program Coordinator for the Opera Theatre of St. Louis Spring Training program.

ABOUT THE ACCOMPANIST

Dr. Joseph Welch is an active and eclectic performer and teacher based in the St. Louis area. As a pianist, Joe performs frequently as soloist, recently performing Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue and Rachmaninoff's Second Piano Concerto. He has served as acting principal keyboardist for the Illinois Symphony Orchestra and Chamber Orchestra. His extensive vocal accompanying has seen him collaborate with such artists as Christine Brewer, Laura Hynes, and Marc Schapman. Within the realm of opera and musical theatre, Joe has served as coach, music director, and conductor. For five years, he has worked at the Midwest Institute of Opera alongside Joshua Greene of The Metropolitan Opera Company. Other recent engagements include working with Marble City Opera in Knoxville, TN, SIUE Summer Showbiz, SIUE Opera Theatre, and the University of Minnesota Opera Theatre. In 2015, Joe established a workshop called The Business of Being a Pianist. This workshop helps prepare young musicians for careers as pianists. Dr. Welch presented his work at the 2016 Illinois Music Teachers Conference. The Business of Being a Pianist is held at McKendree University, where he teaches piano. He also teaches piano and music appreciation at Blackburn College.

ABOUT THE CONDUCTOR

Susan L. Rolá is currently enjoying her third year of retirement from teaching orchestra for 31+ years! She was the Director of Orchestras at Lindbergh High School for 24 years. Prior to teaching at Lindbergh she taught in the Ritenour School District for 7+ years. At Lindbergh, Sue directed the Lindbergh High School Symphony and Chamber Orchestras, team taught at Sperreng Middle School and instructed elementary strings. Under her leadership, the Symphony Orchestra performed at the Missouri Music Educators Association convention on two occasions. They also were aired four times on Classic 99 KFUE Radio in a program called "High School Outreach for the Classics". She established the Lindbergh High School Strolling Strings in 1991. The LHS Strolling Strings is an extracurricular high energy, enthusiastic group of young musicians who perform throughout the Greater St. Louis area. In the winter months she directed the "pit" orchestra for the annual high school musical. Sue received her Bachelor of Music degree in Music Education at the University of Missouri, St. Louis and a Masters of Education Degree from National-Louis University. She earned additional credit hours through Truman State University. Sue maintains a private violin studio and is a member of the Sunset String Quartet as well as the Town and Country Symphony Orchestra. She has served two terms as the High School Orchestra Vice President of the St. Louis Suburban Music Educators Association. She also holds professional memberships with MoASTA and the National Association for Music Education. During her retirement she enjoys adjudicating orchestra festivals in Missouri. Sue's honors include the "Lindbergh Leader" award from the Lindbergh School District in 1998. In 2011 she received the "Outstanding Music Educator" award from the St. Louis Suburban Music Educators Association. The "Secondary String Educator of the Year" award was presented to her by the Missouri American String Teachers Association in 2014. In January, 2015 the St. Louis Suburban Music Educators Association honored Sue with the Prestigious "Hall of Fame" award. In the Fall of 2016, Sue established a new community strolling strings group called "Pizzazz"! Pizzazz is open to students from high school through adult who enjoy playing alternative styles of music. Sue's other interests include, jewelry designer, exercise instructor, scrapbooking, traveling and enjoying her family.
