PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fee for the 5-6 Elementary Honors Choir is \$75.00 per school. Once students are registered, directors will receive an invoice from St. Louis Suburban MMEA District 5 with payment instructions. Upon receiving that invoice, directors will have 30 days to submit their payment for the audition fees. **DO NOT bring money to the event.** Wait for the invoice and follow the instructions on the invoice..

SELECTION

Each director may send up to 8 students (try splitting Part 1 and Part 2 as evenly as possible). Please submit names at the time of registration. NO ALTERNATES.

PREPARATION

Please take the time to prepare your students for this concert. Setting up our students for success will make this a positive experience.

PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

Ladies: Black dress pants (NO SKIRTS), White top (covers the shoulders), black dress shoes (preferably flats).
Gentlemen: White dress shirt (button-up), tie or your choice, black dress pants, black dress shoes.
