The St. Louis Suburban Music Educators Association is offering an excellent program just for our 6th grade string players, regardless of whether they are housed in the middle school or in an elementary school. Students who are eligible must fulfill the following:

- 1. Be a 6th grade string player.
- 2. Have a minimum of one year's experience and be able to read advanced music.
- 3. Be a member of their sixth grade string program.
- 4. Be recommended by the orchestra director.
- 5. The student's school district must be a current member of the Cooperating School Districts of St. Louis.

In order to participate, students accepted to the ensemble must attend all rehearsals and the performance. Any student who misses a rehearsal may not be allowed to perform at the concert. Students who miss more than one rehearsal, regardless of excuse, will definitely not be allowed to perform at the concert. If a student has a school orchestra concert on the night of a rehearsal they must still attend rehearsal and leave early.

APPLICATION/REGISTRATION

- Please use the attached sheet to register your students online and keep them for your personal records. You may fill out the director information form to register your students online at www.stlsuburbanmmeadistrict5.com.
- Please be sure your recommended students can fulfill these responsibilities, including having their own instrument. If you have a concert on the night of a rehearsal, please let me know. Students should still attend the rehearsal, but may leave a little early to make your concert.

- Because of space limitations, you are being asked to recommend only three (3) students to
 participate in this orchestra and one alternate student per school (not per teacher). Of the first
 three students, at least one (1) student should be a lower string (viola, cello, bass) player.
 Students nominated as the alternate student per school will be accepted into the orchestra based
 on instrumentation needs. If you have an outstanding musician that might qualify as a section
 leader, please identify that student. Also, please indicate your violin recommendations as first or
 second violin players. All seating will be assigned through a random seating selection process
 (no auditions are held).
- Registration is online at <u>www.stlsuburbanmmeadistrict5.com</u>. Find the honor ensembles page and click on the online registration link for 6th grade orchestra.
- Please register your students online no later than Friday, October 20, 2023. Directors are
 needed to help with rehearsal tuning, setting up and tearing down, and sectionals. Please do
 your part to help ensure the success of our program. For your convenience, you may check the
 rehearsals that you are able to attend on the online registration form.
- All students participating in a middle school honor group which includes the band, jazz band, orchestra, and choir will pay a participation fee of \$15.00 per student. You must pay for all students that have been registered, making the 6th grade registration fee up to \$45.00 per school. ONE CHECK SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO ST. LOUIS SUBURBAN MMEA DISTRICT 5. Please, no purchase orders. Once you have completed your online registration, an invoice will be generated for your school and sent to you via email.
- Students should wear a white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black shoes to the performance. Young men can also wear ties if they would like.
- Students must be prepared for all rehearsals and aware that seating will be assigned in a random manner.

ATTENTION DIRECTORS

While the St. Louis Suburban MMEA District 5 6th Grade Honors Orchestra is not covered under the MSHSAA rules requiring directors to be present at rehearsals, you are welcome and encouraged to attend and assist with rehearsal supervision. Please volunteer your time to help at one or more rehearsals. Help will be needed with setup, breakdown, tuning, and sectionals at one rehearsal. Come early, leave late...any assistance you can provide will be greatly appreciated!
